

NOTICE OF MEETING

MAYDE CREEK MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT

The Board of Directors of Mayde Creek Municipal Utility District will hold a regular meeting on **Monday, April 27, 2026, at 6:00 p.m.**, at the District's Event Center, 19600 Misty Cove, Katy, Texas, to discuss and, if appropriate, act upon the following items:

11. Operation of District facilities, billings, repairs, and maintenance, including:

 - e. adopt Amended Rate Order; and
 - f. approve Consumer Confidence Report and authorize operator to mail Consumer Confidence Report and file certificate of mailing with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality.

14. Determine general prevailing rate of wages for engineering construction projects in locality of the District and adopt Amended and Restated Resolution Adopting Prevailing Wage Rate Scale for Engineering Construction.

 - c. event security and security agreements; and
 - d. advertising and websites.
